

## Camping Sites

### Mixed Camping

We appreciate that there are different views on Mixed Camping within the Cub Section – different Districts and Counties may give out slightly different guidelines.

There is no POR rule on how Boys and Girls should be accommodated at Cub Camp. However, below is an extract from the Mixed Scouting Ongoing Learning Module Workbook.

*It is good practice to have a mixed adult Leadership team. Remember, not all the adults need to be Section Leaders, and so this might be an opportunity to get parents or other friends and relatives involved.*

*There should be separate sleeping areas for girls and boys..... There might be occasions when separating girls and boys for sleeping is not possible for safety or practical reasons; for instance, if there is one girl in the Pack, it would be safer for her to sleep with the other members of her Pack than sleep alone.*

*Young people and their parents must be consulted before the event and be happy with the arrangements. There should be sufficient toilet and washing facilities to ensure the privacy of the young people*

### Generators

Gilwell Park does allow generators, however, as there will be lots of people camping in close proximity, we ask that if you require a generator that its use is kept to a minimum.

Generators should not be switched on before 8am, and should be switched off no later than 10:30pm.

Generators MUST be used in accordance with the manufacturers guidelines. We strongly recommend that an Earth Rod is used in compliance with BS7671. Generator fuel MUST be stored in BS-approved safety containers

### Fires

NO Fires of any kind will be permitted at CUBJAM, except in Gilwell Park designated campfire areas.

## **Camping Sites**

### Tents

Contingents will be allowed enough space for the following tentage:

Sleeping Tents for Adults and Cubs

Dining Shelter or equivalent large enough for everyone to eat at tables

Kitchen Tent

Store Tent

All contingents will be required to provide a list of tentage and approx sizes so we can allocate a suitable camping area for your contingent.

You will not be allowed "game space" within your camping area. There are plenty of other areas at Gilwell Park where you will be able to take your Cubs to play games.

**We will require contingents to pitch tents as close together as possible – with guylines crossed wherever possible.**

**Our Logistics team will ensure that fire breaks are left at regular intervals throughout the CUBJAM camping sites.**
