

First Aid

Each Contingent will be responsible for providing its own First Aid, and dealing with medicines for its participants.

We will however have a central First Aid team to handle any incidents that occur outside of your camping area, where it will be quicker for us to despatch a first aider.

Our First Aiders will be fully qualified. At least 2 members of the team will be members of St Johns Ambulance or Red Cross.

Our First Aiders will also be available to give advice and support to First Aiders within your contingent. A member of the First Aid team will be contactable 24hrs a day via the CUBJAM Office.

To allow us to be able to deal with such incidents – we will issue a standard Health & Permission form – which all participants in CUBJAM (Adults and Cubs) will be required to complete and return.

You may also use this form within your own contingent.

The CUBJAM Office must be informed IMMEDIATELY should the emergency services be called, or someone be taken to hospital.
