

Visiting Cubjam 2019



Unfortunately we are only able to accept requests for visits from VIPs and members of The Scout Association to Cubjam 2019.

Scouting members such as those in the following roles (or their representatives):
Group Scout Leader, Assistant District Commissioner, District Commissioner, Assistant County Commissioner, County Commissioner, Regional and National Scout Association Staff.

VIPs may also include non-Scouting members such as:
Local or National Dignitaries, Local or National Press, or Scouting Supporters such as sponsors and helpers.

ALL Visitors MUST be registered and approved on our website before attending Cubjam.

Visitors MUST follow the directions on our Travelling To/From Cubjam information sheet which can be downloaded on our website.

On arrival, visitors will be required to report to Passport Control – where they will be issued with a Day Pass.

Any visitor who is not a member of the Scout Association MUST be escorted at all times by a member.

Parents of Cub Scouts

Parents of the Cubs within your contingent are NOT permitted to visit Cubjam unless they are collecting or delivering their child. Parents MUST be instructed to come to Passport Control, which will be clearly signposted within Phasels Wood, from where we will ensure they are guided to your contingent or met with yourselves.

Deliveries to Cubjam

If you are expecting a delivery during your stay at Cubjam (for example a supermarket delivery) – please liaise with Cubjam Office so we can make arrangements for the delivery

The delivery driver will NOT be allowed to enter the camping fields – but will deliver to a secure area within the Phasels Wood Car Park. Cubjam Staff will be available to assist with transporting large deliveries to your camping area.
